Sales tax currency exchange rate type

- Based on top voted [idea](#) (100+ votes)
- Separate exchange rate for calculation of tax amounts in tax currency for documents in foreign currency:
 - Direct recalculation from transaction currency to tax currency
 - Tax amount adjustments in tax currency
- Prerequisites:
 - From version 10.0.35
 - [Tax calculation](#) is enabled
 - [Date of VAT register](#), [Enable exchange rate types for sales tax](#) features are enabled

Universal Tax Rate API - Overview

What is Universal Tax Rate API?

Universal Tax Rate API is a set of standard application programming interfaces that Microsoft has defined in Tax calculation, based on the tax calculation data model. It's an extended feature of Tax calculation that enables external tax services to be connected under the same framework.

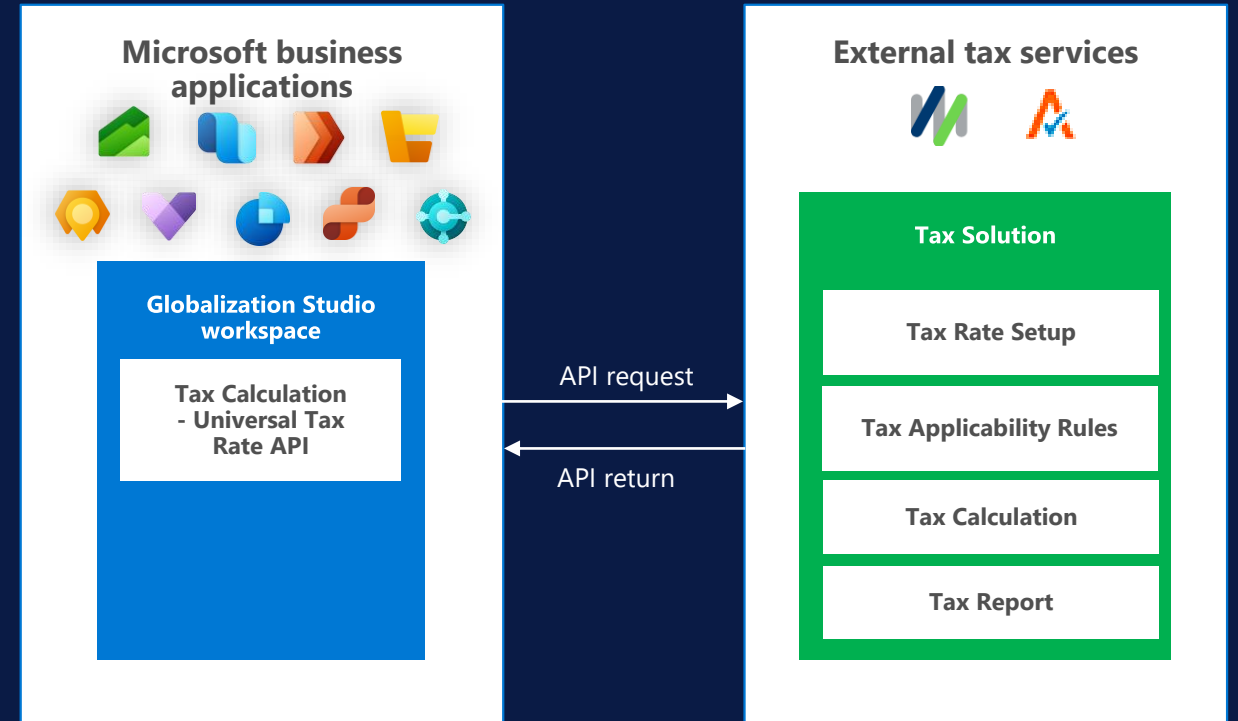
Business values

- Seamless integration with Microsoft Dynamics 365 applications
- Improved scalability
- Reduced maintenance overhead
- Flexibility and customization
- Compliance with local regulations

How does it work with existing Tax Calculation

Universal Tax Rate API extends Tax Calculation for accessing external tax solution provider under the same framework. It's controlled by the feature "**Enable external tax solution providers for Tax calculation service**" released in **10.0.39** and can be further enabled at more granular level:

- Enable by legal entity
- Enable by business process

Universal Tax Rate API - Functions

Encrypted Connection

- The Universal Tax Rate API supports an encrypted connection via Azure Key Vault. This connection helps ensure the security and privacy of data that's **transmitted to** external tax solution providers.

Address Validation

- This functionality lets you validate addresses that are maintained in the global address book. It helps ensure accurate tax calculations by confirming that addresses are valid and complete.

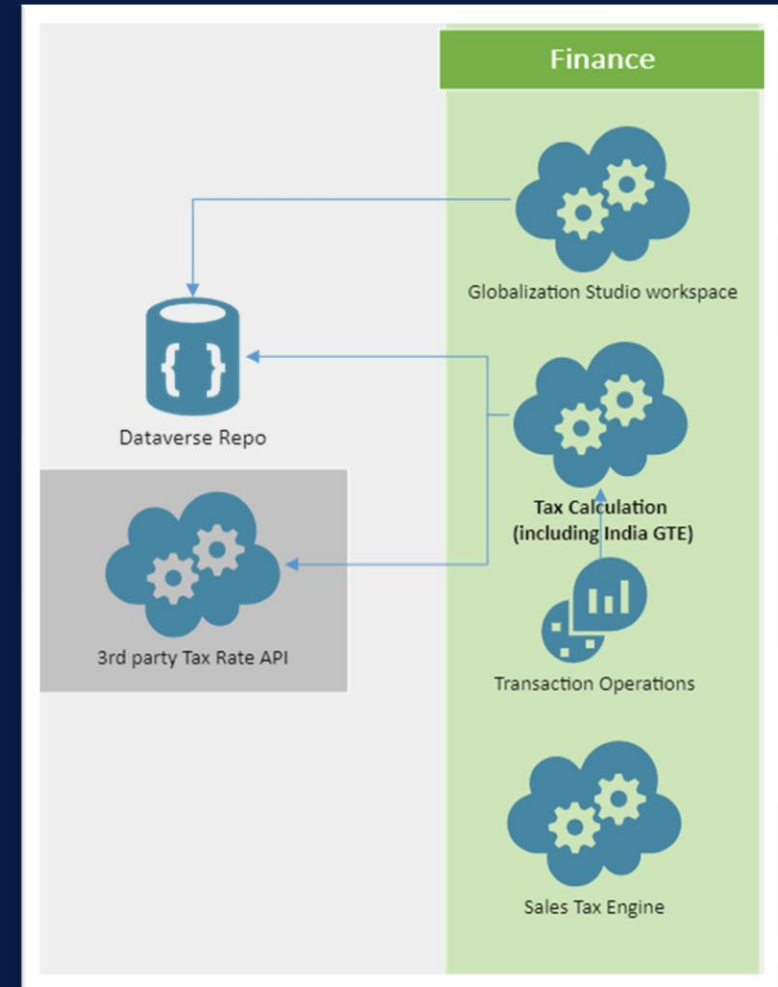
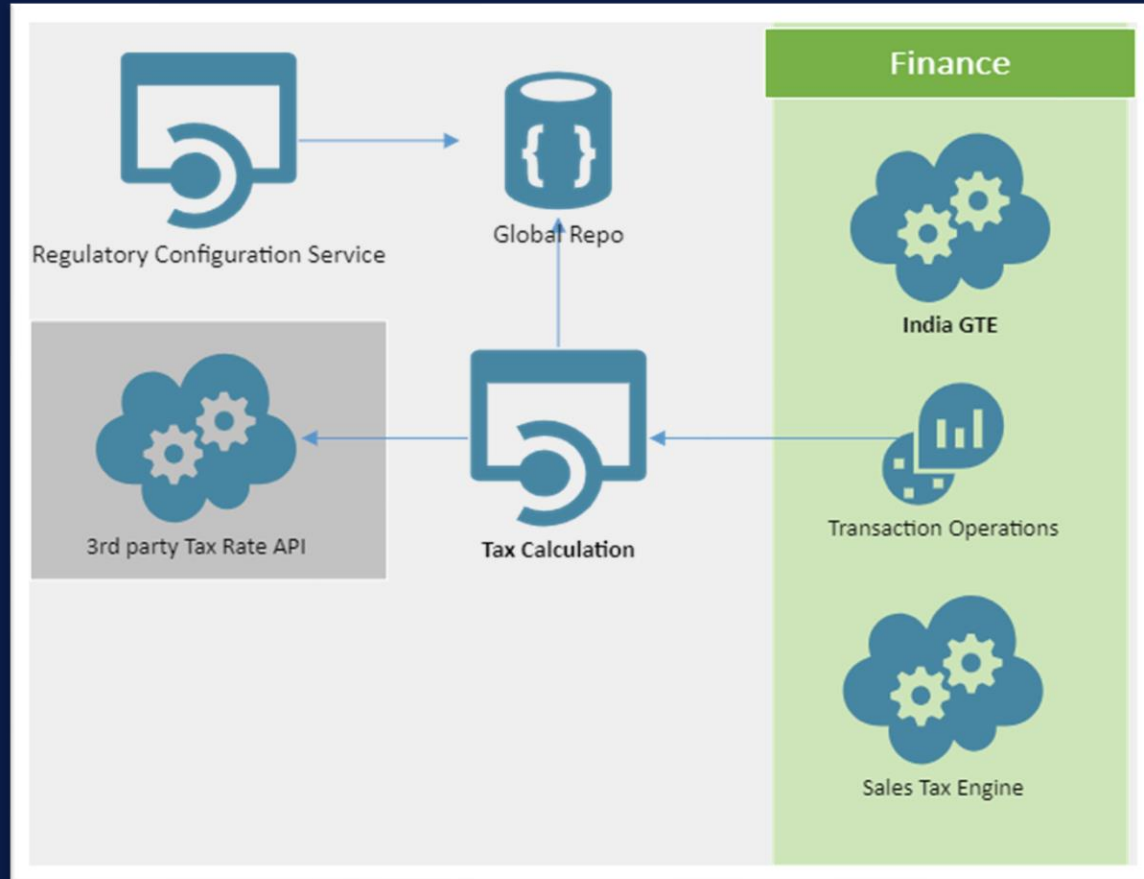
Accrual of Use Tax

- The Universal Tax Rate API enables external tax solution providers to accrue use tax. Use tax is a type of tax that's imposed on the use, storage, or consumption of taxable items or services that weren't taxed at the time of purchase in the United States.

Overcharge Tolerance

- This functionality lets you define overcharge tolerance when the Vendor charged sales tax amount exceeds your tax calculation result.

Tax calculation unification



Tax calculation unification

What is changed?

- The Tax Calculation Service is merged into Dynamics 365 Finance in 10.0.39
- The tax feature setup is moved from Regulatory Configuration Service to Globalization Studio workspace in Finance
- The official tax configuration storage is moved from Global Repo to Dataverse repo
- Tier-2 is no longer the strict pre-condition.

What is not changed?

- All Tax Calculation behaviors in Finance are not changed
- The Tax Calculation functionalities are not changed
- Tax feature and tax configurations are not changed

What uptake is needed?

- No uptake is needed
