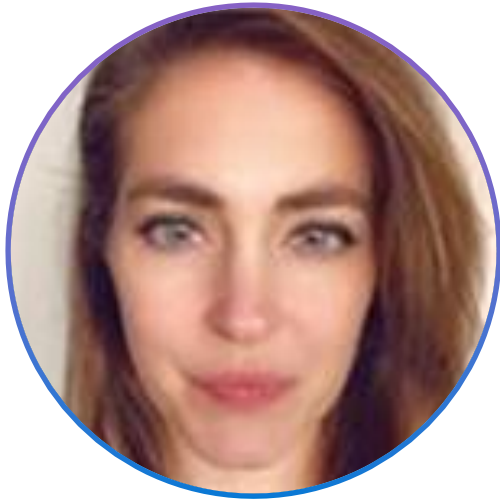

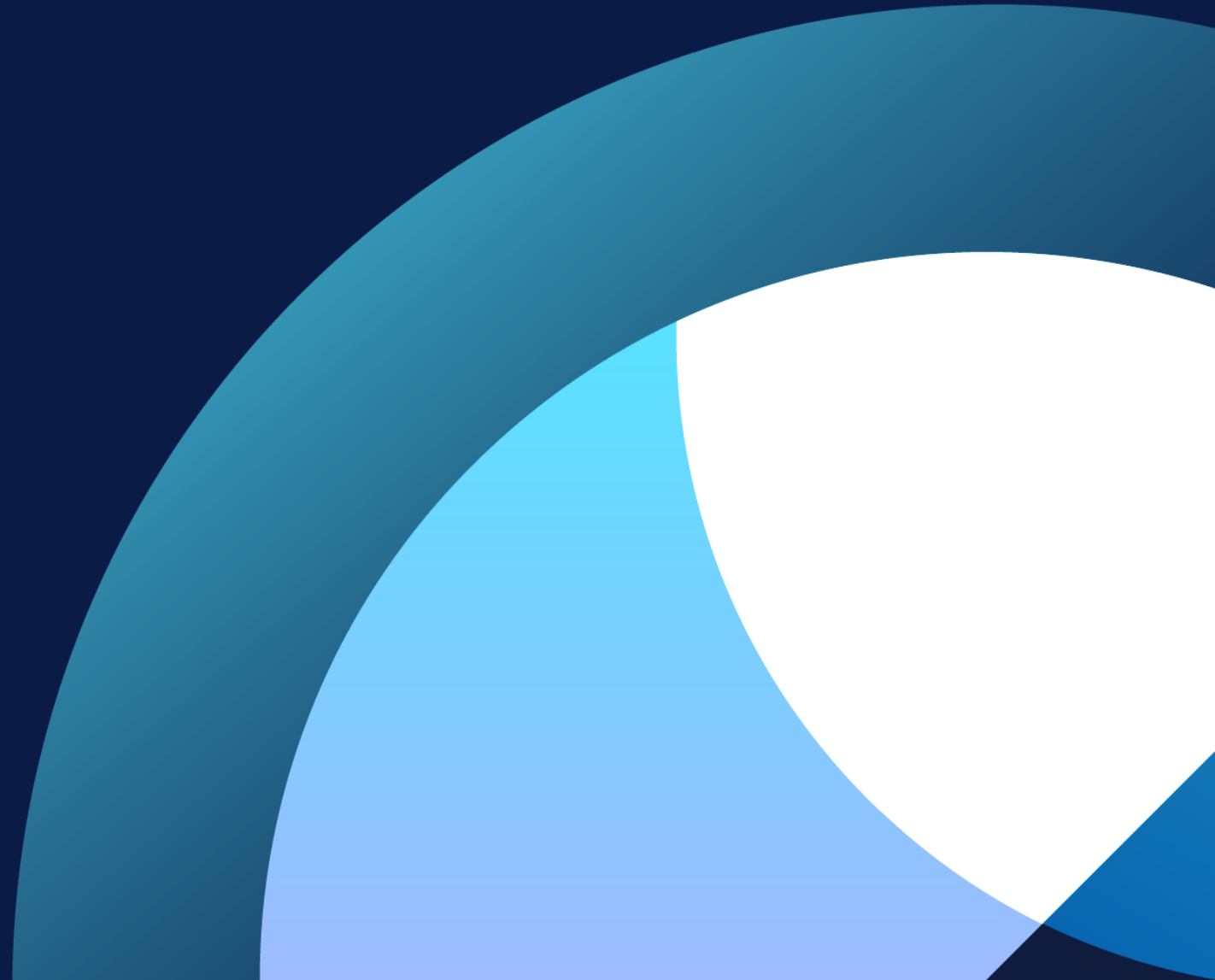

Keeping up with
new features



New feature release process

2 waves per year
(dates are version GA)

- **Wave 1: April – September**
- Wave 2: October – March

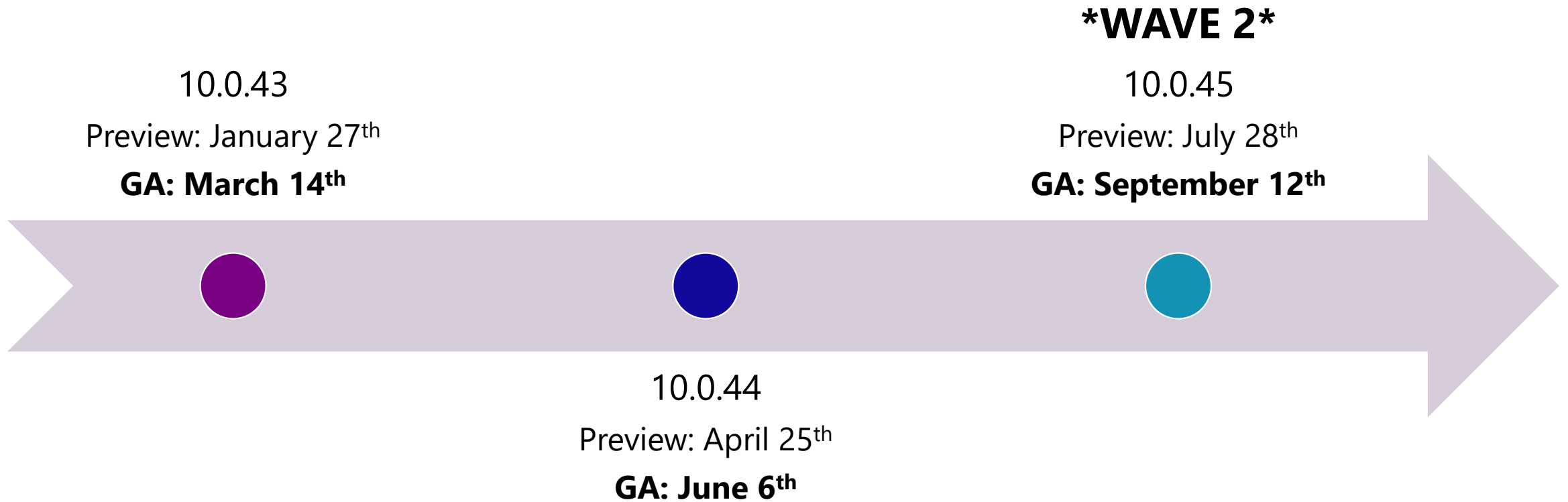
4 service updates
(versions) per year

- Reduced from 7 updates/year
- Additional auto-update window introduced

1 pause update
allowed

- Allowable consecutive pauses reduced from 3 to 1

Demand forecasting and planning enhancements

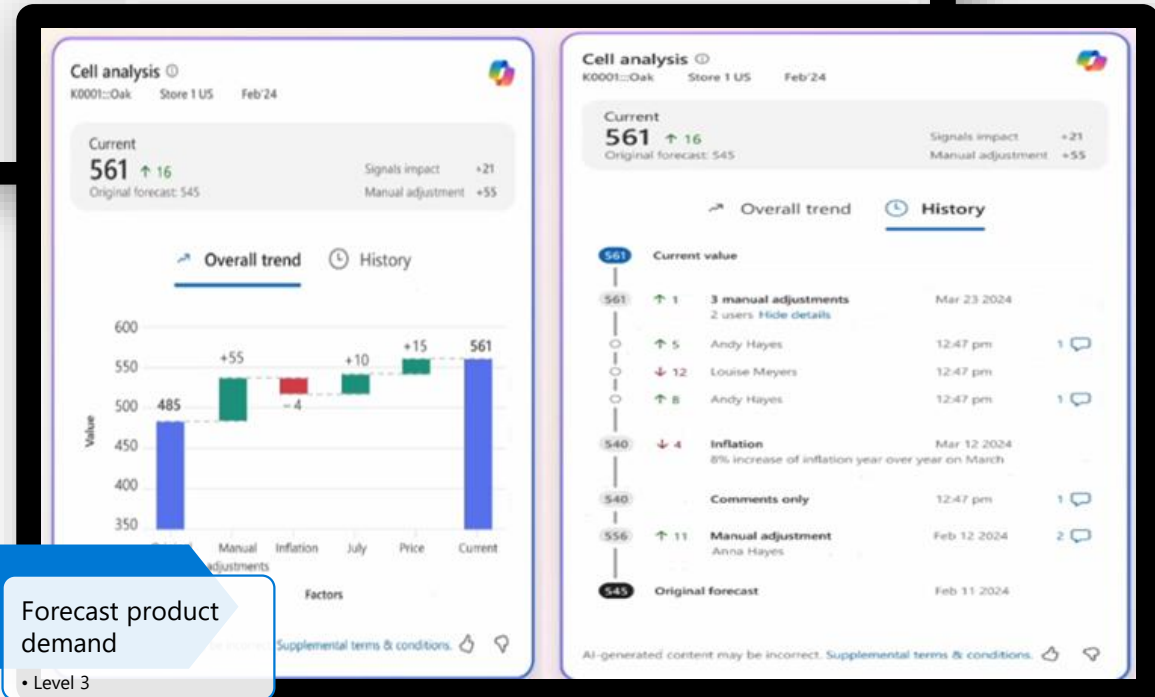
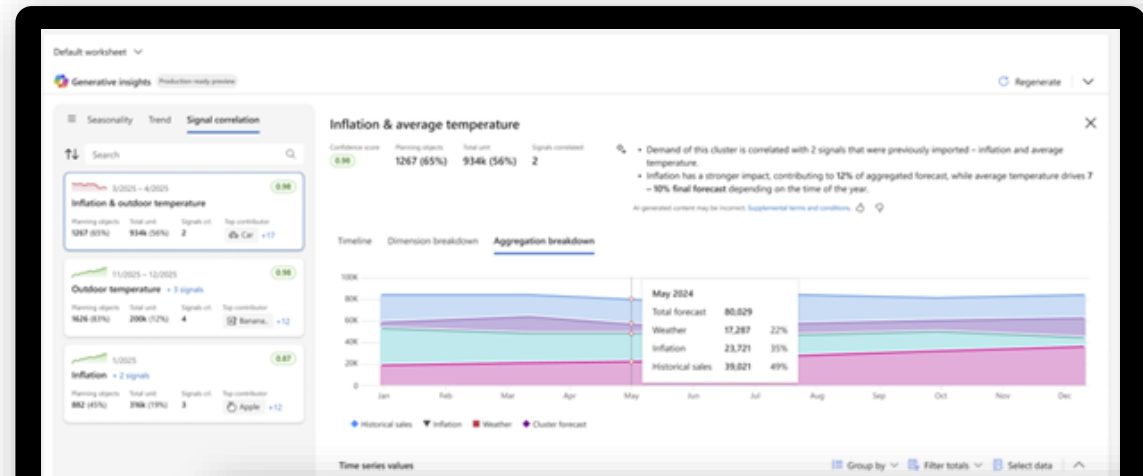
New features enabled by default to improve forecast accuracy in the **Forecast to plan** process

Forecast from top to bottom by allocating demand across different dimensions for **assortment planning**

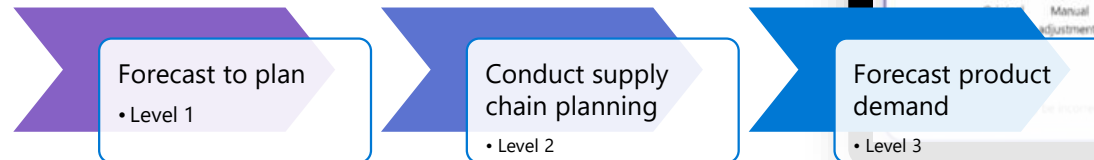
Establish **time freeze** periods

Auto detect seasonality patterns for all forecast algorithms

Define **multiple input signals** and choose between multiple forecast algorithms

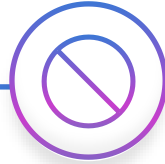
Contract lifecycle management integration

Streamline contract creation, negotiation, execution and renewals in the **Source to pay** process



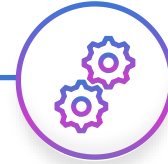
Purchase agreements

The purchase agreement lifecycle can be seamlessly managed between the external CLM system and Supply Chain Management.



Non-disclosure agreements

The NDA lifecycle is managed in the external CLM system and accessible from Supply Chain Management.



Extensible

The feature is extensible. Therefore, you can integrate more contract flows and types as you require.

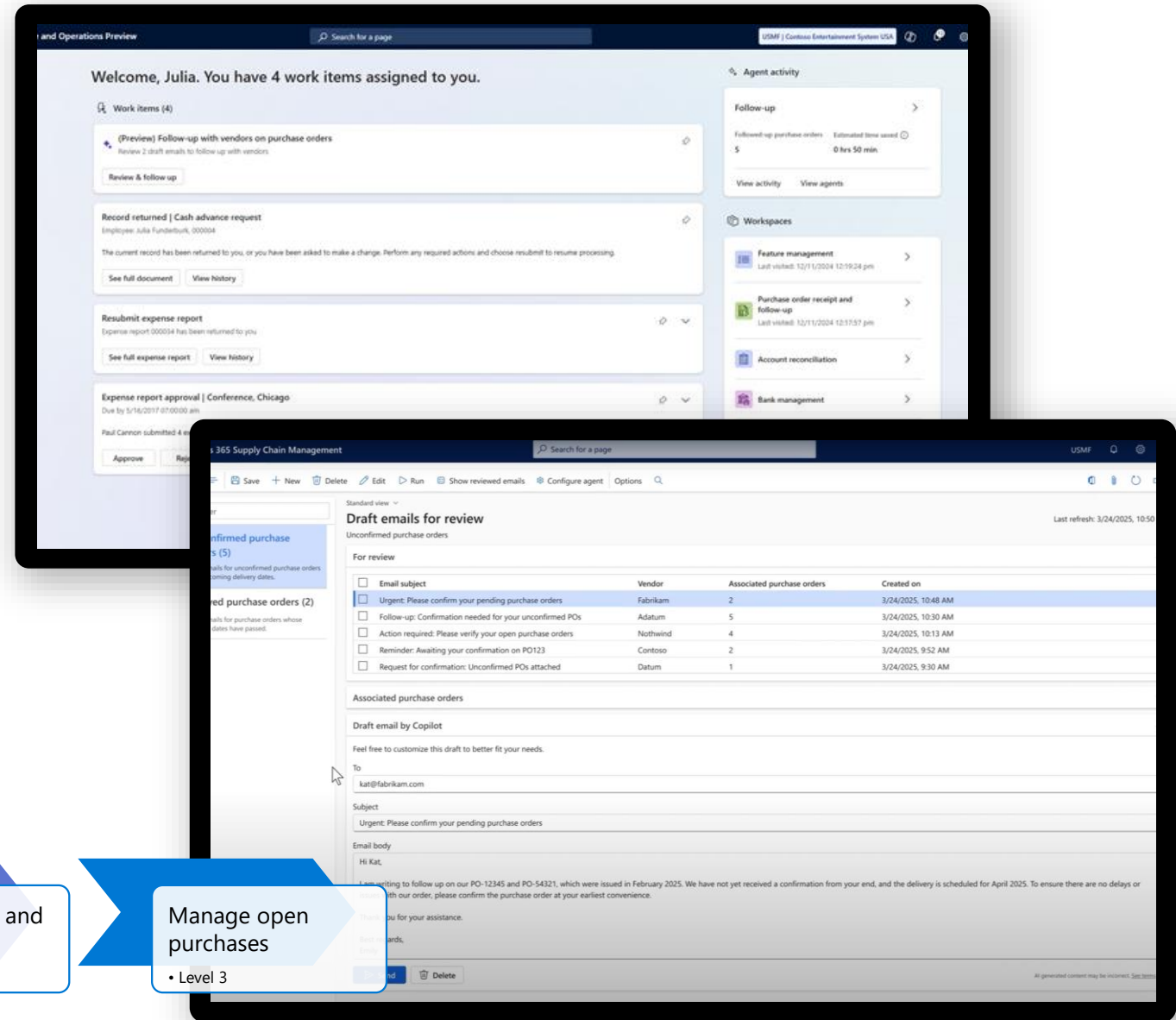

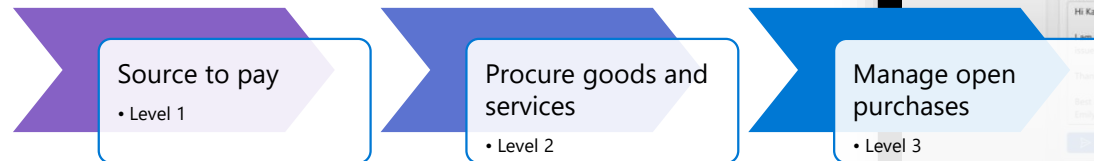

Flexible sampling plans, skip-lot testing, quality-order creation triggers, sample management, instrument calibration, and **acceptable quality limits (AQL)** testing

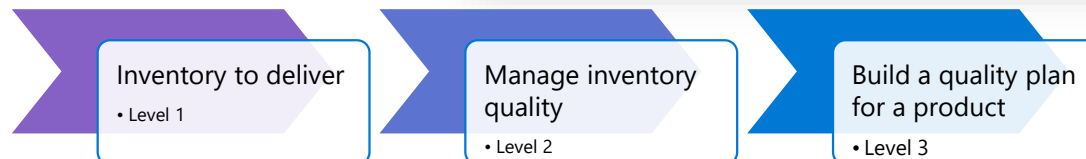
Approved customer lists, customer-specific **certificates of analysis (COA)**, and enhancements to electronic signatures

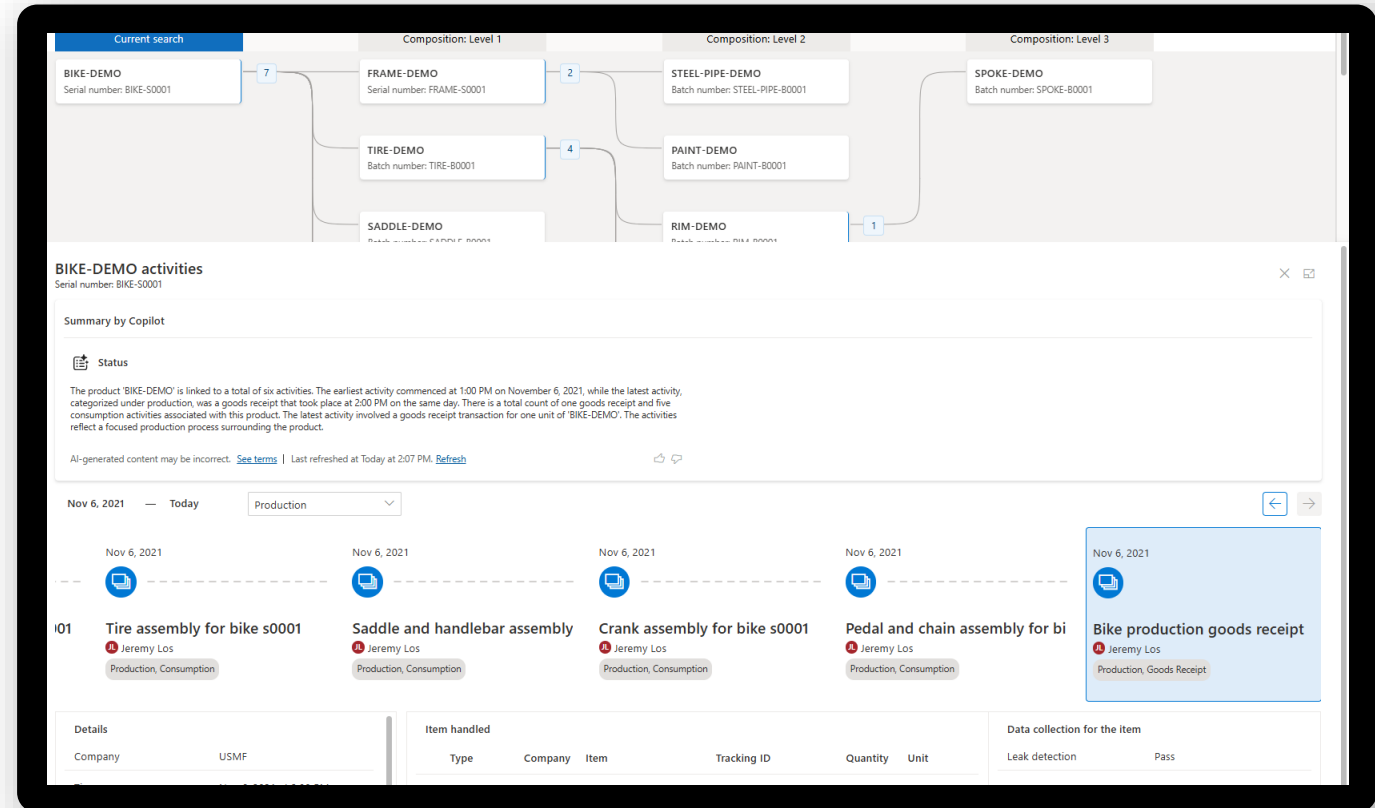

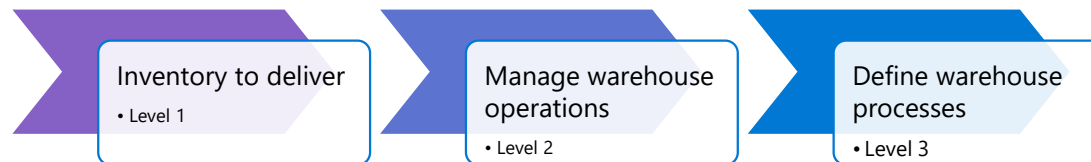

Inventory transactions support for internal warehouse operations

What is it?

- Legacy framework for warehouse inventory transactions

Why are we deprecating it?

- For performance

What do I do next?

- Switch to the new Warehouse Inventory Transactions framework

"Work creation number" number sequence

What is it?

- Legacy number sequence

Why are we deprecating it?

- Potential conflicts with other number sequences

What do I do next?

- Use the *Work creation ID* number sequence instead

Two mobile device menu items must now use process guide

What is it?

- The ability to turn off this option is being removed from the product

Why are we deprecating it?

- The process guide framework offers enhanced extensibility support

What do I do next?

- Use the process guide framework for "Adjustment out" and "Spot cycle counting" work creation processes

Rename item number (preview)

What is it?

- Preview feature that allowed users to edit the item number field

Why are we deprecating it?

- Potential for data inconsistencies, data integrity & data corruption issues

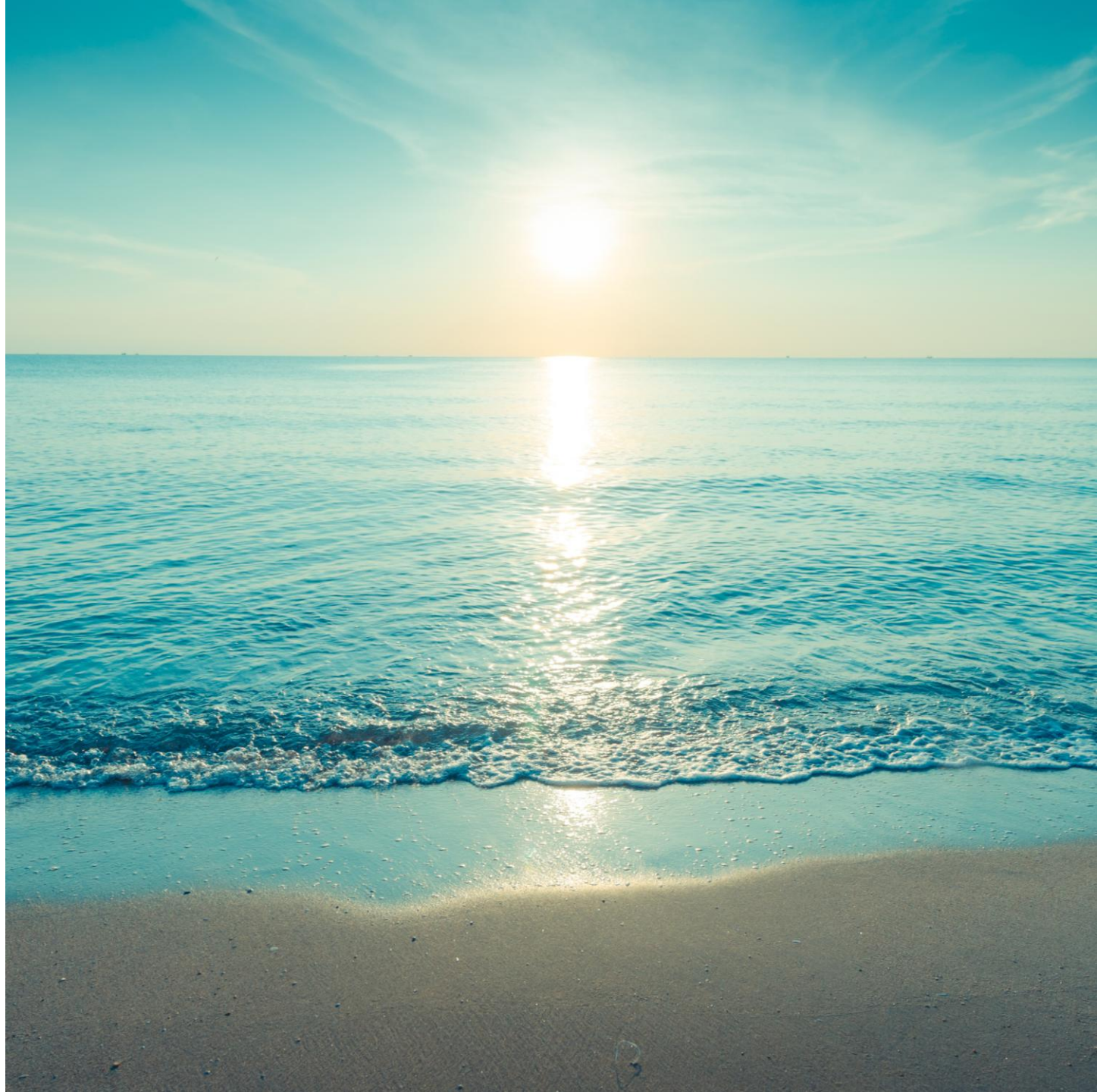
What do I do next?

- Use alternate methods for renaming
